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



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The Academy

Ascend is in a high traffic area in the blossoming south side of the city. Our facility is approximately 1500 square feet of space with one bathroom and ample parking. Licensing Requirements

To be licensed as a massage therapist in Montana, you must follow these guidelines. I have underlined the minimum mandatory requirements:

- Be 18 years or older
- Be of good moral character
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Complete a minimum of 500 hours of in-class supervised instruction from an approved massage therapy school or program
- Pass MBLEx
- Submit a completed massage therapist application form with appropriate fee(s)
- Undergo a background check and fingerprinting
- Provide letters of reference
- Complete CPR/first aid/AED training
- Have massage liability insurance prior to licensing

Our Program

Ascend offers a 625-hour massage therapy program from September to June, with May reserved for make-up time. No prior education is required to start the program. The curriculum covers all necessary knowledge to become a massage therapist. Participants must meet state requirements for a professional license, which include being over 18 years old, having no felony convictions, and possessing good moral character.

First semester. classes are Monday-Wednesday 9-5 with a one hour lunch break. **Second semester**, starting at our *Student Massage Clinic*, we begin our “swing shifts” on Monday and Tuesday only. Students are given a *Clinic Calendar* directing them when to come in that week.

Academic Calendar

Every year, our program aligns with the Butte School District #1 schedule, running from the Monday after Labor Day to the Monday before Memorial Day. We have three breaks: Fall Break, Winter Break, and Spring Break. Our commitment to accessibility is reflected in this approach.

During Fall Break, students can recharge and prepare for the upcoming academic challenges. Winter Break allows families to spend quality time together during the holiday season, fostering a sense of community and well-being. Spring Break provides a much-needed respite as the school year approaches its final stretch.

Additionally, we offer various extracurricular activities and support services to enhance student engagement and success. These include tutoring programs, recreational sports, and arts and cultural events. Our goal is to create a balanced and supportive environment that caters to the diverse needs of our students and their families. By aligning our schedule with the Butte School District, we ensure consistency and convenience for everyone involved, making education accessible and enjoyable.

Modern Massage Practice

This course serves as an introduction to bodywork, beginning with traditional Swedish massage. We will explore the history of massage along with its holistic Eastern philosophies. The textbook for this class is a comprehensive guide covering various massage techniques and relevant information.



Tuition

Pricing & Payment Plan

The tuition for this academic year is set at \$12,500, which encompasses the cost of books and some necessary supplies for school hours. A down payment of \$5,000 is required to secure your enrollment for classes starting in September. I strongly recommend making this payment as soon as possible, as I currently accept only eight students per year, and the down payment is due by August 1st. The remaining balance of \$7,500 can be divided into two installments: \$2,500 is due on December 1st, and \$5,000 is due on May 1st. Please note that, unfortunately, I am unable to accept financial aid at this time. Tuition is accepted in cash, check, or card. If using a card there will be a 5% fee.

Cancellation/Refund Policy


In the event that you submit your down payment and subsequently choose to withdraw your enrollment, Ascend will retain 50% of the required down payment, which amounts to \$2,500, as a withdrawal fee.

Once the program has commenced, the full tuition amount remains due regardless of whether you withdraw, are terminated due to misconduct, or experience any other circumstances that prevent you from completing the program.

Policies & Procedures

Academic Policy

Ascend Massage Academy requires cooperation from its members to maintain order and achieve educational goals. The Academy aims to help students become proficient in massage therapy and qualify for professional practice in Montana, adhering to state guidelines. Academic freedom is valued, promoting open discussion and debate, provided it aligns with the Academy's standards and policies. Additionally, upon admission to the program, students are required to review and sign a comprehensive copy of the academic policy. This document outlines all necessary materials, including guidelines on academic freedom, conduct expectations, and the procedures needed to successfully progress through the program.



Attendance Policy

A. GENERAL RULES:

- Students must arrive on time, in full uniform, and with necessary tools. Instructors may dismiss unprepared students.
- Physical attendance will be recorded.
- All classroom hours and assignments must be completed.

B. TARDINESS:

- Notify faculty by phone if absent or late
- Three grace tardies allowed; additional tardiness may result in delayed entry to class.
- Students must make up missed instructional time.

C. ABSENCES:

- All absences must be made up, including for illness or personal matters.
- A maximum of 5% (8 days) absence is allowed without penalties; emergencies allow up to 10%.
- A \$20 fee applies for make-up hours beyond the scheduled completion date.
- More than 10% absence may lead to withdrawal from the program; Leave of absence is circumstantial and may qualify for re-enrollment. 14 consecutive absences will prompt withdrawal.

D. MAKING UP HOURS:

- Missed time must be made up during designated hours with instructor approval.

Academic Progress

Program is taught in a sequential manner and requires students to complete each class before moving onto the next. Academic progress is measured by:

- Assessments
- Practical Exams
- Student & Instructor Feedback
- Participation & Completion

Graduation Standards

Graduation from Ascend Massage Academy requires the completion of all classes with an average of seventy percent or higher, or ultimately to the discretion of the instructor for practical exams. Students must complete all 625 hours of the program and pay their tuition in full to receive their sealed diploma.



Records and Transcripts

Transcripts are only shared with the student and the governing bodies for licensure and testing, emphasizing the importance of confidentiality in handling sensitive information. Students are given a copy of their transcripts upon graduation, ensuring that their personal academic records are protected and disclosed only to authorized parties.

FERPA Policy

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is a federal law enacted in 1974 that protects the privacy of student education records. Student Conduct

Students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that upholds both professional ethical behavior and academic integrity. This includes being honest in their academic work, avoiding plagiarism, and respecting the intellectual property of others. Students should also engage respectfully with peers and faculty, demonstrating accountability and responsibility in their studies and interactions. These principles ensure a productive and fair learning environment for all.

Grievance Policy

Ascend Massage Academy's Grievance Policy provides a clear process for students to resolve issues fairly and promptly. Students are encouraged to submit grievances to the Grievance Officer, who will acknowledge the complaint within 5 business days and investigate it. A formal response will be provided within 30 business days. If unsatisfied, students can appeal to the School Director within 15 business days. Students may also reach out to the Montana Board of Massage Therapy if the issue remains unresolved. The policy ensures confidentiality and prohibits retaliation, with disciplinary action for violations.

Termination Policy

The violation of this Policy may result in dismissal from the Academy. If a student is dismissed for a violation of this Policy, A refund of one's tuition will not be returned and other actions may be brought against the student if the violation involves either criminal conduct or civil conduct which caused damage to either the Academy Property, Students, or Faculty. The Executive Director makes this decision to terminate a student.



COMTA Complaint Procedure Disclosure

Students and prospective students have the right to file a complaint with the Commission on Massage Therapy Accreditation (COMTA) if they believe the program is not in compliance with accreditation standards. Ascend Massage Academy maintains an internal complaint and grievance process, and students are encouraged to follow institutional procedures first; however, individuals may contact COMTA at any time.
